Germann reported a fund balance of \$113,770.

**Who's Responding** app has been updated – voice quality should be much better. If you experience any voice quality issues let Germann know. Right now ONLY pages on 154.905 are being broadcast and working on having that sent only once – not repeating the 152.0075 page. New England Fire has come on to the system as well.

Germann gave an update for the **Anderson LGR** which will serve the Haley Dam area and to the SE. It will be a shared system with Adams County (Reeder Fire) and Harding County (Reva Fire). The building is here and being prepped. Hoping to have it up and running by end of August. Frequency information was sent to department chiefs. If any department wants Germann to add frequency please advise.

**State Radio** update:

- Currently hiring for seven dispatcher positions.
- Brian Sauter retired leaving only one lead dispatcher who has more than 20 years experience.

**Rural maps** have been updated and copies printed. If you would like additional maps let Germann know.

Discussion on **Baker Tornado** included that it was well organized. Some issues with radio communications. Local communications plan was updated to include more of the MT color scheme. Handouts were provided; for more contact Germann.
