From Cheryl Ryan, AICP, Bowman Zoning and Planning Director:

Fall is here now, and folks around town are trying to wrap their summer projects up and enjoy their yards and gardens to the very end. For many, this includes construction of new decks and fences. Please remember that all decks and fences require a zoning permit. The permit process includes a review of the placement of the deck or fence to make sure the “vision triangle” is maintained when you back your vehicle out of your driveway; and alternatively, to maintain the “line of sight” for an oncoming car. This review is particularly important for corner lots since there are potentially two front yards. It’s a simple review and when done prior to construction, will help you avoid the “Variance” process, and therefore will save you time and money.

Additionally, the Bowman City Commission is reviewing the final chapters of the proposed amendments to the “Land Use Development Code” (also called the “Zoning Code”). If you are interested in providing input on the remainder of this process, please call me at 701-523-7627 for dates and times of the upcoming meetings.

## 48 Hour Parking during Snow Season

To provide safe access for commuters and to avoid high traffic volumes, the street department clears the streets in the early morning hours after snow fall. The 48 hour parking ordinance is enforced so streets can be opened for commuters. The streets have been carefully prioritized according to traffic volume and public safety routes. Bowman's Snow Removal Emergency Route plan: Divide; Ninth Ave; Third St NW; Second St NW; Seventh Ave; after these areas are plowed the residential streets are next. Please note that fine for not moving your vehicle in 48 hours is \$25 minimum up to \$500 maximum.

Bowman City Commissioners meet the First and Third Tuesday of every month at 4 pm at City Hall.
