**TITLE VI NONDISCRIMINATION POLICY STATEMENT**

Bowman County, hereinafter referred to as Bowman County is committed to compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and all related regulations and statutes. Bowman County assures that no person or group(s) of persons shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability/handicap, and income status\*, to be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any and all programs, services, or activities administered by Bowman County, regardless of whether those programs are federally funded or not.

Bowman County also assures that every effort will be made to prevent discrimination through the impacts of its programs, policies, and activities on minority and low-income populations. In addition, Bowman County will provide meaningful access to services for persons with Limited English Proficiency.


In the event Bowman County distributes federal-aid funds to a sub-recipient, Bowman County will include Title VI language in all written agreements and will monitor for compliance.
